Stick and Stone

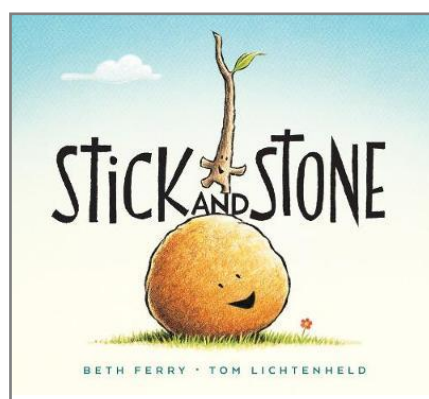
