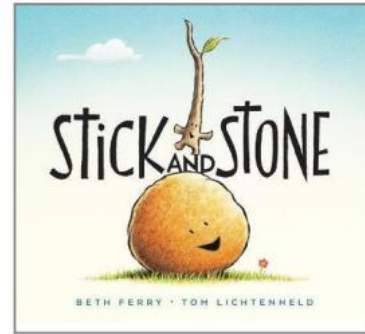




PINK SHIRT DAY
